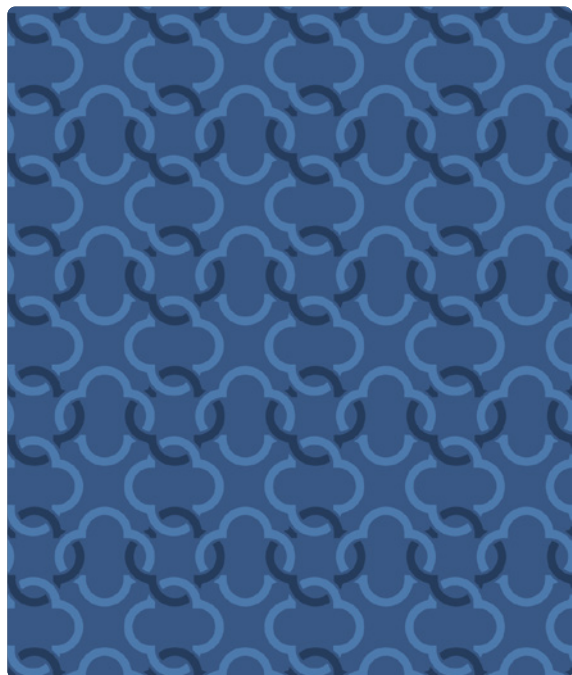




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James Brochin Of Counsel

James Brochin's practice focuses on white-collar defense, complex civil litigation, FCPA, government regulatory matters, and internal investigations. Over the course of his career, Jim has specialized in the hard case, the case which involves difficult legal or factual issues—or often both. In his white-collar practice, Jim represents both companies and their executives in a wide variety of government investigations, including high-profile investigations by the US Department of Justice (including the U.S. Attorney's Offices for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York), the Manhattan District Attorney's Office, the New York State Attorney General's Office, and the Securities and Exchange Commission.

Jim's work over the past several years has included the successful representation of a number of senior C-suite and other level executives in cross-border investigations. In his civil litigation practice, Jim has handled a variety of complex matters in areas ranging from insurance coverage to commercial litigation to securities fraud and shareholder derivative suits to ERISA and antitrust.

Jim is also an experienced trial lawyer, having tried civil and criminal cases in a variety of jurisdictions involving a range of subject matters. Along with his many years in private practice, Jim brings prosecutorial experience, having served as an associate independent counsel in the investigation of former Agriculture Secretary Mike Espy.

Jim also devotes significant time to pro bono work. He regularly represents the Innocence Project, for whom he has filed more than a dozen amicus briefs in courts throughout the country addressing the law concerning eyewitness identification evidence.

- Negotiated favorable deferred prosecution agreement and ultimate dismissal of all charges for CFO of a major multinational telecommunications equipment company charged with wire fraud and bank fraud related to purported criminal economic sanctions evasion in a highly publicized case in the Eastern District of New York.
